

The planet's most beautiful small crustacean, *Cyclops* takes children on an ocean voyage featuring 7 sensorial and interactive explorations of marine life. Immersive, instructive and scientific, the exhibit is geared mainly to children between 6 and 10. The many games, activities and experiments are all fun ways to learn more about the ocean, increase awareness of the environment and understand the world around them.



### Water Above, Water Below

October 2018 — August 2019

This exhibit for all audiences aims to alert the public to the importance of water as a universal resource and to the necessity for its conservation. Produced by the Muséum d'histoire Naturelle, and the Cité de l'Espace, Toulouse, it addresses the role of water in two parts: water below in all its forms and water seen from above, continually studied and monitored by satellites. Interactive displays supplement these two sections.
